

WINDOWS VPN INSTALLATION STEPS

1. It will ask you for your utorid credentials to get to download page and then you'll get to the following page.

CISCO VPN

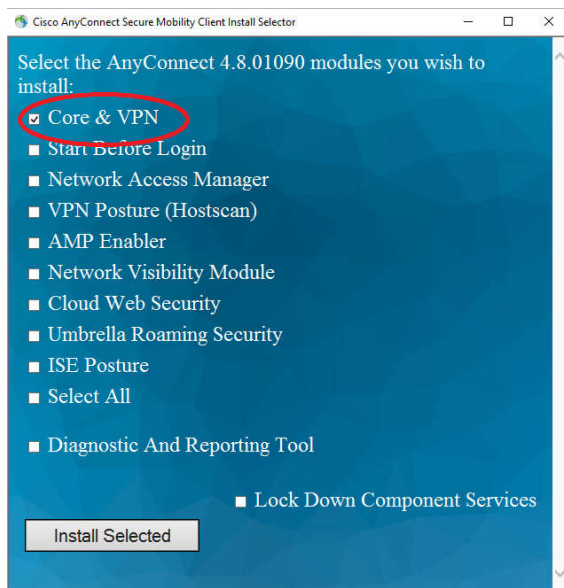
For access to University enterprise applications such as ROSI and AMS using non-web clients, the Cisco VPN is used as a 'shim' between the client and the server to allow the configuration of high assurance access as well as user authorization.

Client Software

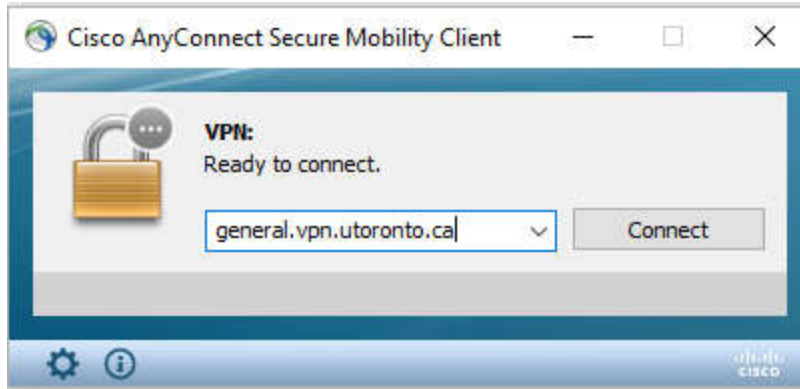
- Cisco AnyConnect VPN **Windows** Client (67.4 MB)
- Cisco AnyConnect VPN **MacOS** Client (32.3 MB)
- Cisco AnyConnect VPN **Linux** Client (27.9 MB)

Download the appropriate version.

2. Extract the files into a folder and then right click the Setup.exe -> Run as Administrator
3. On the window that pops up, make sure to just only have the Core & VPN selected



4. Click on "Install Selected" then Yes and then accept the agreement and let it install.
5. Once it is done, open it up and it should look similar to this.



6. In the text box, type “general.vpn.utoronto.ca” and then click connect
7. It should then ask you for a username and password which is your utorid and utorid password
8. Click ok and it should connect.
9. Once it has successfully connected, you can use your remote desktop file as you have been in the past. Just remember to disconnect from Cisco once you are done to free up the connection.
