Your profile is completely in your control. You can log into <u>Elements</u>, the backend to <u>DiscoverResearch</u>, to hide certain pieces and/or completely remove your profile with a quick toggle.

To make your entire profile public or private:


Start by logging into <u>Elements</u>. From there, click on **Edit My Profile** beneath your picture.

From there, adjust the Change profile privacy level toggle to your desired setting.

<u>Elements</u> will sync with the public <u>DiscoverResearch</u> site in about **five minutes**. Make sure to refresh your <u>DiscoverResearch</u> browser to see the change.

You can always change this again in the future.





To make certain pieces of your public profile internal:

You can also use **Elements** to keep a public profile and manage what content is displayed publically.



To change the privacy level of sections/items, just click on the privacy button next to the item and adjust accordingly.

Make sure to click **Save** to keep the privacy change.




2. Click on the Professional Activities heading








3. Scroll down the page until you see the "Relationship privacy" and click "Public"

4. Click on the heading of the activity




5. Click on the "Manage Privacy Settings" button



6. Change the Professional activity privacy setting to either "Private" or "Internal"








You will see that the privacy icon has been changed to match the privacy setting that you have selected.
